- Why use Datalog to program distributed systems?
 - Conciseness
 - Executable programs generated directly from specifications
 - Database techniques can be used to optimize execution of programs
 - ...
- Is it possible to use Datalog to program distributed systems?
 - Ndlog, Overlog, Dedalus, Meld, ...

- BUT
 - Still something is missing: the capability to express what a node **knows**
 - we are able to think about what a node **knows** and not about low level communication details
 - Programs are more intuitive
 - Nodes can reason about the state of knowledge of other nodes
 - ...
- **Knowlog**: Datalog leveraged with epistemic modal operators
